




European Union Humanitarian Aid

More than **nine in ten Europeans** believe that it is important that the **EU funds humanitarian aid activities.**




82% of Europeans **feel pride, enthusiasm or satisfaction** when thinking about the **EU being amongst the main donors** of humanitarian aid.






When asked how to **make EU humanitarian aid provision more efficient**, Europeans' opinions have been consistent since 2010:



A majority believe that it is more efficient if coordinated **by the EU as a whole**



Others believe it is more efficient if coordinated and provided **by each member separately**

Almost **half of Europeans** think that the EU should **keep the current level of spending** on humanitarian aid activities. More than **four in ten** think it **should invest more**.
